HANDICAP CHAIRMAN—the tournament handicaps are under review. A letter (email) will go out to affected members and they will have two weeks to appeal changes imposed. Gary also gave several examples of tournament handicap calculators and asked for input. A motion was made for the tournament handicap that the club will use both home and away events for the best five of the last ten scores during the previous 12 months starting May 1st, 2008. If fewer than ten scores are posted during that time frame, then an average of 50% or more of the best available scores will be used to get a minimum of three scores for the calculation. This motion was conditional on the flexibility of the software available to do the calculations—motion passed.
