Harry has worked with Golf Genius to make sure next year's master roster and calendar are ready to go.

Tournament Bookkeeper and Treasurer's Report: Jose has all tournament money updated and the Golf Genius payment for next year completed. He handed out the board gift cards today. He will have the 2026 Budget prepared next month.

Secretary's Report: A reminder email to renew the membership was sent out to everyone. Another will be sent out around Thanksgiving and a final one prior to the late fee going into effect. Old Business:

- A motion was made to charge late renewing members \$10 if they sign up after

- A proposal was made to create a pool that people can join to help cover the costs of scoring a hole in one. Jose will send out a proposal to the board later.
- Harry has a meeting with the Trophy company to get them updated.
- Tom met with the First Tee Association and wrote up a summary of eligible players for the Roseville Golf Club Local Youth Scholarship Awards. He will continue to refine the write-up so that ultimately an eligible senior(s) is recognized. The amount of the scholarship is still unavailable because all monies will still need to be raised.
- A proposal was made to re-work the Tournament of Champions to better recognize the overall Gross and Net winner. The following ideas were brainstormed: making the tournament a separate two-day tournament where the low gross and low net would be crowned; bringing back the player of the year points; recognizing the gross and net winner with a special prize like a hat, shirt, or club headcover; changing the season to start in October and culminate at the Invitational tournament so that these champions could be recognized at the Invitational. The tournament committee will discuss and provide a proposal.
