

## Handicapper's Message



Hello everybody,

I have heard that there are concerns/questions in regards to Tournament Handicaps. The Tournament Handicaps are based upon your best five of the last ten tournament rounds that you have played. Tournament Handicaps do not include the Rose Cup, Diamond tournaments or any other tournaments run by the pro shop of Diamond Oaks. The Tournament

Handicaps are updated every three tournament rounds and also prior to all our major tournaments.

I also want to remind you that it is not too late to sign up for the Eclectic Tournament. We have only had one tournament so far with 12 tournament dates (10 tournaments) including the three-day 54 Hole Tournament yet to be played. The cost is only \$10! You can sign up either by mail, dropping it off at the pro shop or via PayPal (<http://www.rosevillegolfclub.com/schedule/2011/2011%20Tournament%20Schedule.htm>). You can also sign up on the day of the Masters Tournament (or any other tournament for prospective tournaments) by submitting payment with entry slip to Doug Smith, Tournament Bookkeeper.

## Rules Chairman

### Rule 3-3 Doubt as to Procedure

When you are in doubt as to how to proceed or you have doubt about whether you are entitled to relief, a second ball can be played. Here is the key part of the Rule. For the complete Rule, refer to your Rules of Golf book that you carry (?).


**“...After the doubtful situation has arisen and *before taking further action* The competitor **MUST** announce to his marker or a fellow competitor That he intends to play two balls and *which ball he wishes to count* if the Rules permit.”**

**“The competitor must report the facts of the situation to the Committee *before returning his scorecard.* If he fails to do so, *he is disqualified.*”**

**Two more thoughts:**

**Report to the Committee must be made even if the score with both balls is the same.  
This procedure applies only to stroke play, not match play.**
