## **Vice President's Message**

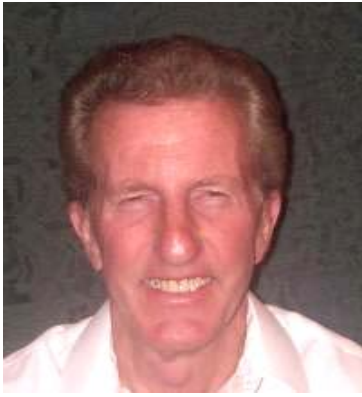

## **Tournament Director's Message**

Here it is April and we have been fortunate so far this year, in that, we have been able to play golf in very good conditions. We need the rain that's for sure, but if you are a golfer, rain is the last thing you want to see while playing a round. The good weather has resulted in very successful turnouts for all of our winter tournaments and I hope that will carry over into spring.

We have a number of appealing play dates on the horizon to be sure so sign up early and guarantee your self a spot in the field. This month we will be focusing on the Zone Qualifier. This is a team event and you should have yourself a partner before entering this tournament. Although we will try and assist you it is not the responsibility of the committee to find a partner for you. Since most players are signing up by the due date we have fewer and fewer people on standby lists so the opportunity to find a partner will be slim at best. If you are looking for a partner, the best way to communicate your needs would be to utilize the new "Message Board" feature that can now be found on the RGC website. This is much more effective and will result in you finding someone you want to play with rather than playing with someone that the committee chooses for you.

We will also introduce the new weekday events this month. These will be run just the same as any other RGC event and you must be an RGC member to participate. There will be a due date and a play date. The winnings will be posted to your accounts at Diamond Oaks. We will also run a skins game and the events will be flighted. We will use GHIN handicaps only and the handicap you will play to on the "play date," will be determined by the handicap that you carry on the "due date." The due dates and play dates are shown on the tournament schedule which can be found on the RGC website.

As stated in earlier an e-mail, our play date at Somersett Country Club in Reno was cancelled by that facility. They did, however, find us a venue at Arrow Creek also in Reno, for the same day, same time, same price, with all of the same amenities. The folks at Somersett would definitely like to have us utilize their facilities next year and we may look at that scenario with some conditions put in place.

Also in 2013, we will have to find a different venue to play in Monterey other than Poppy Hills. As you have no doubt heard, the entire course will be closed for the entire 2013 season for a complete renovation of the course and the facilities.

## Tournament Bookkeeper's Message

Many of our members have been asking about how to add notes to their entries when using PayPal.

Start with the RGC tournament schedule as posted on our website. Simply select the tournament you want to play in, click on "cost" and the website directly links you to the PayPal secure payment site. (If you are only signing up for one tournament skip the next paragraph.)

If you wish to play in more than one tournament, when you see your shopping cart, select "Continue Shopping" and you will be returned to the tournament PayPal "blue" page", and from there click the "back button" on the browser to return to the tournament schedule. You can add all the tournaments for the remainder of the year if you wish.

As you choose a way to pay, PayPal asks if you have an account.

If you have a PayPal account, proceed by entering your email address and password. Then, continue to the next page, where you will see your order details on the left side. On the right you see your shipping address. Directly below your shipping address you will see "Note to seller:

". Click on "Add" and enter the note that you want to send to the Tournament Director or Tournament Bookkeeper.

If you don't have a PayPal account, now is the time to set one up. If you don't want a PayPal account, select the bottom hyperlink that takes you to the credit card section. Enter your credit card information. Click on "Review and continue". You should now see "Note to seller:

". Enter the note you want to send, for example, whom you want as a partner in the next event or your foursome.

It's as simple as that.

## Rules Committee Message

This year we have few new rules and decisions you should know. This quarter I will explain two related changes:

1. **Definition:** “Addressing the ball – A player has addressed the ball when he has grounded his club immediately in front of or immediately behind the ball whether or not he has taken his stance.”

This is important because it eliminates addressing the ball in a hazard as you cannot ground your club in a hazard. It also means you have addressed the ball on the green or elsewhere as soon as you have touched the ground as described above.

### 2. Rule 18-2b Ball Moving After Address

“If a player's ball in play moves after he has addressed it (other than as a result of a stroke) the player is deemed to have moved the ball and incurs a penalty of one stroke.”

“A new Exception is added that exonerates the player if his ball moves after it has been addressed when it is known or virtually certain that he did not cause the ball to move. For example, if it is a gust of wind that moves the ball after it has been addressed, there is no penalty and the ball is played from its new position.”

This is a significant change. I'm sure many of you have seen or experienced the wind causing a ball to move. That particular penalty is now a thing of the past.

It is important to note that gravity is specifically not considered an element that should be considered when applying the Exception. If the ball moves after it has been addressed and there is no wind, water or other element to cause it to move the player is deemed to have caused the ball to move. The ball must be replaced and the player is assessed a one stroke penalty. (Decision 18-2b/11) So make certain the ball is completely at rest before you address it.

I am happy to discuss this and any other rules at the open meeting.

Hello RGC Members:

There is a new feature on the Roseville Golf Club website that you will want to check out; the RGC Message Board. Just click the "RGC Message Board" link at the top of the home page. We have implemented the message board as a means for members, on their own, to find playing partners for team events ahead of time and remove that responsibility from the tournament director. If you want to play in a team event and do not have a playing partner, post a message on the message board or reply to a message someone else has already posted. Do this well in advance of the tournament entry deadline to give you time to exchange contact information and get your entry forms in to the tournament director. When posting a message for a playing partner (or replying to a message), don't forget to include: the name of the event, your name and contact information and maybe your handicap. Try to keep the messages short and to the point. Also, feel free to use the message board to find playing partners anytime for just a fun round of golf. This would be a great way, especially new members, to meet other members in the club. So, start posting today, and have fun.
