Rules Committee Message

The “slow play rule” has been a remarkable success and I give credit to all of you for your efforts to keep play moving. We have only assessed a few penalties since we instituted the rule and I believe everyone enjoys the faster pace of play.

The rule simply states that you will be penalized if you finish in over 4 hours and 40 minutes AND are more than 15 minutes behind the group in front of you. If you keep an eye on the group in front of you your pace should keep you out of trouble. Play ready golf and do not get too hung up on honors or being furthest away. You can do this without being inconsiderate. Just say you are going to hit (not during someone’s. backswing).

One misunderstanding we have encountered is the 5 minute allowance to look for a lost ball. This allowance is only related to the time you have to find your ball before it is declared lost. It does not grant you an additional 5 minutes to finish the round within the slow play rule. Your group is still responsible for maintaining the pace of play.

Keep on keeping up.

Handicappers Report

We are half way through the golf season. The weather has been excellent for us so far this year, but the HOT weather is just around the corner. We have had a few issues this year with some medical exemptions and a few restricted handicaps. Nothing outside of the usual issues, however. I have had a few questions posed to me about the yearlong Eclectic event. One or two have questioned the overall results to date. I need to remind the players that all stroke events are not eligible for the Eclectic scoring and I would direct you to the calendar of events for the club. Only the events shown in red are eligible for Eclectic scoring and there are only 6 events left on the calendar that are Eclectic events, all culminated by the Eclectic Final in December. Some have asked me if it is too late to sign up for the Eclectic and the answer is "no". The only proviso is that any results from events prior to your sign-up date will not be counted in your total.

I will be updating the Tournament handicaps after the Firecracker tournament and the updated Eclectic Results will also be posted by the end of July.

Finally, I have had a few players who have posted their results after tournaments. A reminder is that I will post all tournament scores for you. The posted score will include the ESC adjustment for your handicap. Please do not post following your tournament rounds. Thank you and good scoring to you for the rest of this golf year.
