I compliment all of our members for their efforts to understand and apply the rules of golf. A vast majority of questions brought to the Rules Committee have been handled properly during play. Most players have played a second ball and then sought a ruling at the completion of the round. For the most part players have made the correct ruling during play but chose to get a ruling just to be sure. In a few cases they may have been disqualified had they not played a second ball. For example if the player took relief when he was not entitled to he may have been penalized and ultimately signed an incorrect scorecard. So if you are not sure, get a ruling. We would rather help you avoid a penalty than have to assess one later.
