SECRETARY'S MESSAGE



Handicapper's Message

Welcome to the 2013 Golf Season with your Roseville Golf Club. A reminder to please NOT post any of your scores from RGC sponsored events. I will post your revised scores and they become part of your Tournament handicap. A second reminder is that the Roseville Golf Club uses the lower of your GHIN handicap or your Tournament handicap for Roseville golf club events. I have had some members argue that the Tournament handicap is unfair, because they concentrate more during tournaments and that is why their tournament handicap is lower. I always thank those people because they are validating the use of Tournament handicaps in our club.

If any member is considering changing their tee assignment for 2013 from Blue to White or White to Blue, please let our Tournament Director, Neil Thomas, know that before your first tournament of the year and he will include you on his list of White tee players (or take you off).

Once again this year I will be in charge of the Eclectic year-long event. Once you sign up for this, I will track your best scores on each of the 18 holes at Diamond Oaks on each eligible stroke pay event. These events are listed in the Tournament schedule and are highlighted in red. It is a fun and interesting event and you can see how well you do overall on Diamond Oaks throughout the year. I will track your scores once you sign up, but will not go back to past events, so sign up early. The first eclectic event of the year is the Super Bowl tournament.

Rules Committee Message

Welcome to winter golf in Roseville. The club has established authority to take “preferred lies” also known as “lift, clean and place” during the wet and muddy conditions. (See Conditions of Play for each tournament.) There is a proper procedure to take relief:

- Always mark your ball before you lift it.
- You may clean the ball and then place it within one Diamond Oaks scorecard no closer to the hole. Once you have placed the ball in its new position it is in play and you cannot touch or move the ball again other than with a stroke.
- You may not improve the lie when you place the ball. Pushing down the grass with the ball or anything else is considered improving your lie. However, you can remove loose impediments.
- Preferred lies do not apply in a hazard.

As always, check with a Rules Committee member if you have any questions regarding rules. When in doubt play a second ball and get a ruling at the end of the round before you sign your scorecard.
