Hi everybody, I will be your new Tournament Director. Let me give you some background information about myself. I was previously a Board Member from 1998 – 2004 and 2006 – 2011 including previously as Tournament Director 1999 – 2000, President in 2002 and Handicapper 2006 – 2011. I also recently served on Committees for Tournament, Handicap and Rules.

We are going to be trying something new with skins this year. Starting with the Super Bowl, we will be having all-flight skins instead of individual flights. This will result in fewer payouts but the payouts will be much larger. We will alternate tournaments using all-flight skins and individual-flight skins. If we have good feedback on the all-flight skins, we will permanently change that.

At all Roseville Golf Club tournaments held at Diamond Oaks, men play from the Blue or White tees and women play from the Red or White tees. The default for the men is Blue tees and for women is Red tees. If you would like to play from the White tees, please let me know via email but be aware once you change your default to White tees, you have to play them for the rest of the year.

If you ever need an early or late time, please notify us when you submit your entry and we will try to accommodate you. Some of the major tournaments require that your tee time is based on score and probably not be able to accommodate you for those tournaments.

If you would like to work on the Tournament Committee, please drop me an email. I would love to have you as a member of the Tournament Committee.
