Handicap Chairperson Message

Hello everybody, welcome back. Today, I'm going to talk about a feature that you may not know about the NCGA App. You now have the ability to post your scores hole-by-hole for your casual (non-tournament) rounds. To access this, all you need to do is instead of hitting the Adjusted Gross Score at the end of your round is to hit Hole By Hole at the start of your round. This will bring up the screen below.

After you complete a hole, you enter your score for that hole. If needed, the App automatically adjusts your score for posting purposes (You don't have to calculate your Net Double Bogey). You will also see if you want to use it, the App gives you the ability to enter your putts, Green-In-Regulation and Fairway Hit (Left symbol is for left hits, Right symbol is for right hits, Up Arrow is for ball you hit through the fairway and Down Arrow is for balls that don't reach the fairway). At the end of 18 holes you just hit Post Score and you're done. Once you complete a few rounds, you can then hit the My Stats button and the App will have different statistics it has compiled for you.

Rules Chairman Message

Hello RGC Members,

I hope you and your family are healthy and doing well. We are all ready to get back into the swing of things but reopening our tournament play requires some COVID-19 play adaptations. I wanted to make sure we are all on the same page on the two affecting the rules of play, holing out and bunker play.

In all RGC stroke play tournaments, the ball must be holed out. We are lucky that Roseville has chosen the hole insert and ball retrieval lift wire at Diamond Oaks. If you have played other courses lately, you know this represents the only option to actually 'hole out'. The adaptive rule states that the Player may not touch the flag and must use his /her putter, not their hand, to pull up on the wire to retrieve the ball. Besides some of us getting used to putting with the flag in, there is an issue. If the ball hits the flag, or unfortunately, the lift guide wire and bounces off, the ball is still in play and you must continue until holed out. I understand that the guide wire is problematic, and everyone will have an opinion if the ball would have dropped or not. However, just remember we all must play with the same rules and enjoy the fact we can play golf again! The adaptation for bunker play will not make much difference for RGC. Since rakes do not make a dent in what we generously call bunkers, they will not be missed. With COVID-19, we are playing all bunkers as 'preferred lies'. This means you can mark, lift, and place the ball in the bunker within one club length, no closer to the hole.

Finally, the Rules Committee has revised the RGC Local Rules for 2020. This was needed to bring USGA Rules references up to date, defer to existing USGA Rules and standardize local rules procedures. The revision will be posted on our website for your review. Please take a read through the revision and let me know any feedback or concerns. The revision will be brought up for Member approval at the next Open Meeting.
