MyNCGA App is retiring October 1, 2022. NCGA is recommending that our members use the GHIN Mobile App for score posting, handicap lookup, stats tracking, score history and more – such as golf course GPS. I, myself, have been using the app for non-tournament rounds and I love the simplicity of using it. After, you post the round, it immediately gives you information about the round such as number of putts, GIR's etc. and will give you your probable index updated.

RULES CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT



Hello RGC Members,

I hope everyone has had an enjoyable season this year. We have seven (7) club events remaining which includes our away event in Monterey on October 15th and 16th. We're scheduled to play Poppy Hills and Monterey Pines. I hope many of you signed up to play.

Recently, a club member inquired about the penalty areas on the left side of the fairway on Hole 6 and below the canyon on this hole. These areas are posted "Environmentally Sensitive Area" with signs stating access to these areas is prohibited. The club member wanted clarification about these signs because some players have advised that you cannot play your ball in these areas and others say you can. **These signs have not been recognized by the RGC for club events and players are allowed entry to these penalty areas to retrieve or play their ball. Remember, when searching for your ball there is a maximum search time of three (3) minutes.** Also, Local Rule 6.a states: "If a player is unsure if a shot has cleared the mid-hole canyon, to save time, the player may play a provisional ball as per Rule 17.1d. If the original ball is found outside the Penalty Area, the ball must be played."

Hopefully, this clarifies these signs. Enjoy the remaining scheduled events and see you at the course. As always, if you have a rules question you can drop me an email, text message or call me or just discuss with me at the course.
