I'd like to take a moment to remind you to post your golf scores the same day you played your round. The reasoning behind this is sometimes the course playing conditions factor in an automatic adjustments. It is imperative to post the same day to receive these adjustments and posting at a later date will not factor in any adjustments. I'd also like to remind you that all RGC

RULES CHAIRPERSON'S MESSAGE

Finally, spring is here!!

There are some changes in the rules of golf from the USGA this year. Below is a link for you to take a look at those changes.

Key Changes to the Rules of Golf Set to Take Effect in 2023

- 1. Always replace divots and repair ball marks on the green.
- 2. Do not talk or make noise when someone is taking their shot.
- 3. Play ready golf
- 4. <u>Do not touch the ball or remove any obstacles, such as rocks or branches, unless it is allowed by the rules.</u>
- 5. Do not walk in the line of another player's putt.
- 6. Do not play until the group ahead of you is out of range.
- 7. Keep up with the pace of play and allow faster groups to play through.
- 8. Do not move the ball to improve your lie, except as allowed by the rules.
- 9. Always be respectful of other players and the course

<u>Fallen Trees</u> -- Some of this winter's fallen trees have been removed but not all. Relief for stance, swing, and line of sight is allowed without penalty. Lift, clean, and place the ball no nearer the hole at the nearest point of relief from the fallen tree.

<u>Penalty Area Between #6 and #8 Greens</u> - This area has two ponds and a bed of rocks. The ponds are marked with red stakes and the rock area should also be. The course is getting more red stakes for us. That entire area is considered a penalty area.

Please take 5 minutes and review your club rules if a question does arise, make sure to bring it to the rules committee's attention before you sign your scorecards. Have a fun and fair golf year!
