Rules Chairman Message

We are looking forward to an exciting 2023 Club Championship and fall season! It has been an excellent season thus far. Very few rule violations have happened thanks to all of you for monitoring play and being diligent about communicating any potential rule while playing. As we enter the club championship below are some rule reminders about match play.

BASIC MATCH PLAY RULES
Rule 2-6: General Penalty

The penalty for a breach of a Rule in match play is loss of a hole except when otherwise provided. There are no 2-stroke penalties in match play.

There are loss-of-hole penalties and 1-stroke penalties only.

Rule 2-4: Concessions

A player may concede a match at any time prior to the start or conclusion of that match.

A player may concede a hole at any time prior to the start or conclusion of that hole.

A player may concede his opponent's next stroke at any time, provided the opponent's ball is at rest. The opponent is considered to have holed out with his next stroke, and the ball may be removed by either side. A concession may not be declined or withdrawn.

Rule 2-5: Doubt as to Procedure

In match play, if a doubt or dispute arises between the players, a player may make a claim. If no duly authorized representative of the Committee is available within a reasonable time, the players must continue the match without delay.

The Committee may consider a claim only if the player making the claim notifies his opponent (i) that he is making a claim, (ii) of the facts of the situation, and (iii) that he wants a ruling.

The claim must be made before any player in the match plays from the next teeing ground or, in the case of the last hole of the match, before all players in the match leave the putting green.
