>>> VICE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


What a fun start to our season! Now, the fun really begins as we get better weather and more complete fields in our tournaments.

HANDICAPPER'S MESSAGE

Hello fellow golfers.

I thought I would share with you some changes to the World Handicap System. Nine hole scores now count toward your Handicap Index the very next day. Your score will b e combined with an expected Score Differential for consistency and fairness. You can also now post scores if you only play 10-17 holes, just be sure to use the hole by hole posting method. Shorter courses (9 holes less than 750 yards and 18 holes less than 1500 yards) are now eligible for a Course Rating and Slope Rating so you can use your Handicap Index at more courses.

Please be aware that you do not need to post your scores for RGC tournament events as I post them for you. If you have any questions please email me at RGChandicapper@gmail.com or call or text me at 530-682-4444.

The events are getting bigger and bigger, so get your entry in as early as possible to allow us to get more tee time from the course if needed. Hope to see you all out there soon. Thank you!



>>> TOURNAMENT BOOKKEEPER'S MESSAGE

My name is Harry Wharff. I'm the Tournament Bookkeeper for our club. I'm the person you send your entry fees and skins money to and, if needed, the cancellations for the tournaments. If you need to cancel for a tournament, the money will be refunded back to the way that you paid for that tournament (Memberplanet, Venmo or Zelle). When you sign up and want to get into skins the Fees are \$5 for gross and \$5 for net or \$10 for both. If you are playing in a team event just remember it is team skins and both players need to be in. Please check with your partner if you will be participating in the skins game. For team skins, the fees are \$10 gross and \$10 net or \$20 for both per day for the team (\$40 per team on a two day event for both skins). Also, when you are signing up please include a note indicating what tournament and who you would like to play with. We will try, if possible, to accommodate your request. We will be changing the app that you will be using to record your scores during play. The app you need to download on App Store for iPhone or Google Store for Android phones is Golfsoftware. This app works the same as previous software, but with more reliability. After you download the app please go in and register with your email. The app will provide you with a password to use for all tournaments. If you cannot get the app to download or set up please see me at the signup table before each tournament. I will have a printout of the instructions to sign up and sign in. Contact me via email or phone.

>>> RULES CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

I have finally retired (I gave up that bad habit called WORK) and will have more time to dedicate to updating the local rules. There are a few redundancies in our rules and things like "how to take a drop in the case of an immovable obstruction" are not unique to our club and I will clear those out. We have several rules regarding where to take a drop or when to take a drop and those will remain. It is the players responsibility always to be familiar with the rules of golf and apply them as written. The USGA did all of us a favor back in 2023 when they simplified the rules and allowed things like your club touching the sand in a bunker or a ball being moved by natural forces (like wind) where there is no penalty, The ball just needs to be replaced before taking your stroke. The rules committee will also attempt to simplify our local rules and you will see those changes put in place for the 2025 season.

We have had no major rules issues so far this year. It is difficult to mark the course in rainy conditions as the paint simply washes away. Now that we are into drier conditions, I will take a look at the course prior to our competitions and mark some areas that are either abnormal or unusually wet. I look forward to the year ahead and hope not to have to make a ruling during competition, but that is what I am here for. Hit 'em straight.
