VP Message: Dan needs a couple of reports for the upcoming newsletter. A blurb will go out identifying the upcoming board positions. For the Invitational, tee prizes were discussed.

Tournament Director: 57 players are signed up for DOTO #6. 47 are slated for Lakeridge and 44 are signed up for Toiyabe. RGC is continuing to work with DO to make sure that enough tee times are set aside for tournaments.

Tournament Bookkeeper and Treasurer's Report: All tournaments have been paid for except DOTO #5. The club finances are doing really well at the moment.

Correspondence:

- A member brought up the need for a more equitable handicapping system for 2-man events moving forward. The suggestion was to use a player's lowest index from the last 12 months. The tournament committee will investigate further.

- Ron sent out an email from the NCGA stating that membership fees would remain the same next year. Ron also updated NCGA club-finder information.

Old Business:

- Jim provided costs for tee prize options for the Invitational. Custom logo towels or custom ball markers were offered and priced. Dan is also looking into a metal expandable container that keeps cans insulated and cold.
- Invitational raffle prize ideas: foursomes at Plumas Lake will be investigated by Harry and John will ask Sierra View.
- Elections are a month away. The new president will need to appoint the Tournament Director, Tournament Bookkeeper, Webmaster, Rules' Chairperson, and Handicapper. Jim E is interested in running for member-at-large again. Dan plans to run for president, and Scott will run for vice-president. Jose will run for tournament bookkeeper/treasurer, and Paul will run for secretary. All open positions will be advertised in the upcoming newsletter.

New Business

- Robert Guild recently passed away and his memorial will be held in September. A moment of silence will be held on Sunday at the start of the Club Championship tournament. Tom Firchau recently passed as well and a moment will be held for him at the same time.
- A proposal was made for a legends bracket in the upcoming club championship. Those over 75 would qualify. The white tees would be played.
